PULMONARY FIBROSIS IS A DISEASE THAT IS FATAL, THERE IS NO CURE.

Pulmonary fibrosis (PF) is an interstitial lung disease that affects an estimated 30,000 Canadians, with a projected 5,000 deaths each year. In patients with PF, the lung tissue becomes scarred and over time, thickens and becomes more widespread. In turn, the lungs lose their ability to transfer oxygen to the bloodstream, resulting in shortness of breath and vital organs being deprived of the necessary oxygen to survive. Progress has recently been made and now there are two drugs that try to slow the process. Still lung transplant is the only real hope.
