WHEREAS recognizing Pulmonary Fibrosis Awareness Month helps to highlight the importance of early diagnosis, increased support for affected individuals, and the need for continued investment in research and advocacy;

WHEREAS the Government of Prince Edward Island is committed to working with organizations like CPFF to improve healthcare access and resources for those affected by pulmonary fibrosis.
